AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 10584  
(NEW SERIES) TO ESTABLISH A REVISED  
SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND  
EMPLOYEES IN THE UNCLASSIFIED SERVICE OF  
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San  
Diego as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 10584 (New Series) of the  
ordinances of The City of San Diego is hereby amended to  
revise the schedule of compensation for officers and employees  
of the Unclassified Service of The City of San Diego by  
amending Exhibit C. This revised schedule of compensation  
shall be given retroactive effect to July 1, 1971 as it  
relates to those unclassified employees who are in the  
positions set forth in the amended Exhibit C on the effective  
date of this amending ordinance.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in  
force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

Section 1.
