AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 10584 (NEW SERIES) TO ESTABLISH A REVISED SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES IN THE UNCLASSIFIED SERVICE OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.
