ORDINANCE NO. 10659

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VI, ARTICLE 2, OF THE  
SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING DIVISION 8, AND  
SECTION 62.0801, RELATING TO STREET CLOSINGS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,  
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VI, Article 2, of the San Diego  
Municipal Code be amended by adding Division 8, STREET  
CLOSINGS, and Section 62.0801 to read as follows:

DIVISION 8

STREET CLOSINGS

SEC. 62.0801 STREET CLOSING FEES

- (a) Purpose and Policy. The City of San Diego encounters considerable expense in processing applications for street closings. It is the purpose and policy of the Council to establish a fee schedule which shall be paid by the petitioner upon the filing of a request for the processing of an application for a street closing in order to reimburse the City for expenses incurred.
- (b) The fees established by this section shall be paid under the provisions set forth hereinafter:
- (1) A fee of \$35.00 for the cost of investigating proposed street closings shall be paid to the Planning Department at the time of filing the application for the street closing. This fee is nonrefundable.

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(2) A fee of \$165.00 at the conclusion of the investigation for the costs of all services provided by the City in processing an approved petition. Fifty percent of this fee shall be refunded if the City is notified in writing prior to the ordering of posting of notice and advertising that the applicant desires to withdraw his application.

(3) Where the petitioner requests that a map or plat be prepared by City, an additional fee of \$35.00 shall be paid for each such map or plat. This fee is nonrefundable.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

1. Purpose and Policy. The City of San Diego encounters considerable expense in processing applications for street closings. It is the purpose and policy of the Council to establish a fee schedule which shall be paid at the time of filing of an application for a street closing and to be reimbursed to the City for expenses incurred. The fee established by this section shall be paid under the provisions set forth hereinafter.  
(1) A fee of \$50.00 for the cost of investigating a proposed street change shall be paid to the Planning Department at the time of filing the application for the street change. This fee is non-refundable.  
(2) A fee of \$100.00 at the conclusion of the investigation and the costs of all services provided by the City in processing an approved petition shall be refunded to the City if notified in writing prior to the opening of posting of notice and advertising that the applicant desires to withdraw his application.  
(3) Where the petitioner requests that a map or plat be prepared by the City, an additional fee of \$50.00 shall be paid for each such map or plat. This fee is non-refundable.  
This ordinance shall take effect on the thirtieth day of the month of passage.
