AN ORDINANCE CALLING A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND IN THE SAN DIEGO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT TO BE HELD TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 1971.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby ordered that a General Municipal Election will be held in the City of San Diego on Tuesday, the 2nd day of November, 1971, for the purpose of electing the following municipal officers:

MAYOR,	Four-Year Term
COUNCILMAN, District No. 2	Four-Year Term
COUNCILMAN, District No. 4	Four-Year Term
COUNCILMAN, District No. 6	Four-Year Term
COUNCILMAN, District No. 8	Four-Year Term

Section 2. It is hereby ordered that a General Municipal Election will be held in the San Diego Unified School District on Tuesday, the 2nd day of November, 1971, for the purpose of electing the following members of the Board of Education:

MEMBER OF BOARD OF EDUCATION, District A	Four-Year Term
MEMBER OF BOARD OF EDUCATION, District D	Four-Year Term
MEMBER OF BOARD OF EDUCATION, District E	Four-Year Term

Section 3. For the purpose of said elections, the election precincts shall be the precincts established by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego; provided, however, that certain of said precincts shall be consolidated in the manner indicated on the list of consolidated precincts on file in the office of the City Clerk.

Section 4. The City Clerk shall designate the polling places, and shall appoint the members of the precinct boards for said elections.

Section 5. That the polls for said elections shall be open from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, the 2nd day of November, 1971.

Section 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to procure and supply the required number of ballots, sample ballots, equipment, supplies and other printed matter.

Section 7. The Cubic Votetronics Vote Counting Devices approved for use by the State Commission on Voting Machines and Vote Counting Devices shall be used to tabulate both precinct and absentee ballots.

Section 8. The following rates of compensation are hereby established for said election:

Rental of Polling Place	15.00


1.00 to each precinct board member transporting election packages to collection centers, one way only, up to ten miles; for distances in excess of ten miles the reimbursement to one of the two precinct board members shall be \$1.00 plus 50¢ for each five miles in addition to the first ten miles, but not to exceed a maximum of \$8.50, and to the other precinct board member shall be \$1.00.

Section 9. The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause this ordinance to be published once in the official newspaper of The City of San Diego.

Section 10. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
