AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VI, DIVISION 6, ARTICLE 1 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 61.0601 RELATING TO THE ACQUISITION OF OPEN SPACE LANDS FOR PARK AND RECREATION PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VI, Division 6, Article 1 of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and it is hereby amended by amending Section 61.0601 to read as follows:

SEC. 61.0601 PURPOSE AND INTENT

The purpose and intent of this ordinance is to establish procedural methods by which open space lands may be acquired, improved and maintained for park and recreation purposes. The City may acquire open space lands by succession, annexation, purchase, devise, lease, gift or condemnation.

"Open space land" means any land or water area:

(1) which is primarily in its natural state and has value for park and recreation purposes, and

(2) which, in the opinion of the City Council of the City,

(a) conforms to the criteria established for open space land set forth in the "Progress

as amended, and

(b) would, if retained in its natural state  
or improved, enhance the present or potential  
value of abutting or surrounding properties or  
would maintain or enhance the conservation of  
natural or scenic resources.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in  
force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

~~If the area to be acquired does not meet the first two of the above criteria, it may nevertheless be acquired pursuant to this Ordinance, but the power of condemnation may not be utilized for such acquisition.~~
