WHEREAS, Rancho Bernardo Country Club, a California corporation, has applied to the City Council for two Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate automobiles for hire within the limits of the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 72.13 of the San Diego
Municipal Code, the City Manager has caused an investigation
to be made and has reported his findings in writing to
the Council, which report indicates:

- a. There is a demand of the public for automobiles for hire in the Rancho Bernardo area;
- b. Western Greyhound bus service connects with

  Rancho Bernardo and downtown San Diego, providing a

  connection with San Diego Transit System; taxicab service

  is provided at a cost not considered reasonable for most

  people in the Rancho Bernardo area;
- c. Applicant has shown satisfactory financial responsibility and is experienced in hotel management and related transportation needs;
- d. Two 1970 Checker Aerobuses, 12-passenger capacity, conforming to local and State requirements for public transportation vehicles are proposed to be used by applicant;
- e. The proposed service will not materially affect traffic conditions or create additional traffic hazards;

- f. San Diego Transit Corporation believes this service should be on a no-charge basis, while applicant proposes to bill each room at Rancho Bernardo Inn, regardless of number of occupants, five dollars extra for this service;
- g. San Diego Transit Corporation believes this service may conflict with its service sometime in the future, while the San Diego Police Department recommends issuance due to the need for such a service; and

WHEREAS, the City Council on this date, after public hearing, has considered the contents of the City Manager's report and finds it to be accurate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

That Rancho Bernardo Country Club, having filed application for two Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate two vehicles for hire pursuant to provisions of Section 72.11 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and the City Manager having conducted the aforementioned investigation, two Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity are hereby granted to Rancho Bernardo Country Club to operate the vehicles specified in the applications subject to compliance with all provisions of the San Diego Municipal Code and subject to the following two exceptions:

1. These Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity shall last for two years only; and

2. Service under these Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity is limited to registered guests at the Inn at Rancho Bernardo.
