1. That the base bid of \$13,803.00 by DBX, Inc., dba Perry Electric, a corporation, for the MODIFICATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNAL AND SAFETY LIGHTING SYSTEMS AT INTERSECTIONS OF 30TH STREET AND MEADE AVENUE, 30TH STREET AND "C" STREET, 30TH STREET AND BROADWAY, AND PALM STREET AND PACIFIC HIGHWAY, in the City of San Diego, California, is hereby accepted; and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract therefor in accordance with the form on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 734442.
2.
