WHEREAS, Whitney M. Young, Jr., a warrior in the vanguard of the struggle for equal rights for blacks and other minorities, died on March 11, 1971; and

WHEREAS, his impact upon the lives of millions of people from all strata of society reflects the potential for peaceful achievement of meaningful reform; and

WHEREAS, his life provides us all with an unparalleled example of selfless compassion for his fellow man which is all too often sorely lacking in each of us; and

WHEREAS, his untimely death still leaves humanity in the midst of that struggle with victory not yet in its grasp; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of San Diego declares this, the 16th day of March 1971, to be a day of mourning for Whitney M. Young, Jr. and urges the people of San Diego to join with the Mayor and members of the City Council in actively pursuing the goal he defined as "A true America for all people."
