

RESOLUTION No. 202274

Adopted on MAR 30 1971

To improve and to establish the grade in the ALLEY lying between BLOCK 3, FIRST ADDITION to OCEAN SPRAY TRACT and portion of LOT 5, PUEBLO LANDS SUBDIVISION LOT 1783, ALLEY, BLOCK 38, FAIRMOUNT ADDITION, and to improve and to re-establish the grade in the ALLEY, BLOCK 48, TRACT 1368, RESUBDIVISION of FAIRMOUNT ADDITION.

WHEREAS, the hearings provided for in RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 201874 have been held at the time and place fixed, and all continuances, if any, were duly made and ordered; and

WHEREAS, at said hearings all persons desiring to be heard were fully heard and all oral and written protests and objections, if any, were fully considered and this Council gave all persons present an opportunity to hear and be heard in respect to the proposed improvement; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. Written protest or objection against the proposed improvement has been made by the owners of more than one-half of the area of the land included within the assessment district or of the area of property to be assessed. Each and all oral and written protests and objections, if any, made or filed in the matter are hereby overruled and denied.

2. The proposed improvement within the limits mentioned in RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 201874, as amended by Resolution No. 202273, is hereby determined to be feasible and that the lands to be assessed therefor will be able to carry the burden of such proposed assessment, and that the public convenience and necessity require the proposed improvement, and that the Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931 shall not apply.
