

RESOLUTION No. 202535 Adopted on APR 27 1971

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

That the acceptance by the City Manager of that quitclaim deed of THE PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY, a corporation, executed in favor of The City of San Diego, bearing date December 18, 1970, quitclaiming to said City an easement over portions of Lots 1316, 1317, and 1321, of the Pueblo Lands of San Diego, as said lots are shown on map made by James Pascoe, in 1870, and filed for record as Miscellaneous Map No. 36, on November 14, 1921, in the Office of the San Diego County Recorder, as more particularly described in said quitclaim deed, as certified by the Property Director be, and the same is hereby approved.

That the City Clerk of said City is hereby authorized and directed to transmit, upon acceptance by the City Manager, the foregoing said quitclaim deed to the Property Department for recording and further disposition.
