A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AND DENOMINATED AS THE KNOX PARK UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT.

202533 WHEREAS, by Resolution No. a public MAY 1 8 1971 hearing was called for on at the hour of 9:30 a.m. in the Council Chamber of the City Administration Building, 202 C Street, San Diego, California, to determine whether the public health, safety or general welfare require the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within that certain area of the City of San Diego more particularly described as follows:

The easterly 68 feet of Lots 25 and 26, Block J, Alta Vista, Map No. 1029; that portion of the John F. Kennedy Elementary School site lying between the south line of Ocean View Boulevard and a line parallel to and 10 feet southerly of the south line of Ocean View Boulevard and between the easterly line of the John F. Kennedy School site and a point approximately 140 feet westerly; Block 1, Lee's Addition, Map No. 1092 (Knox Park);

said district to include the following-described public right of way:

Ocean View Boulevard between the easterly property line extension of Gloria Street and the westerly cul-de-sac approximately 200 feet westerly of the west line of 40th Street; Gloria Street between the northerly property line extension of Ocean View Boulevard and the southerly line of T Street;

and all as more particularly shown on that certain map entitled KNOX PARK UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT dated April 5, 1971, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 735756 and attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing has been given by the City Clerk to all affected property owners as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and the utilities concerned in the manner and for the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, such hearing has been duly and regularly held and all persons interested have been given an opportunity to be heard; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The City Council does hereby find and determine that the public health, safety and general welfare require the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within the area set forth above and that pursuant to Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the

above-described area is hereby declared to be an underground utility district in the City of San Diego, and the map and document referred to above are hereby incorporated as a part of this resolution.

- 2. The City Council does hereby fix the date of OCT 1 1971 as the date upon which the property in the District must be ready to receive underground service, and does hereby order the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within said District by NOV 11 1971
- 3. The City Clerk be, and he is hereby instructed to notify all affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and all affected utility companies of the adoption of this resolution within ten (10) days after the date of such adoption. The City Clerk shall further notify said affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code of the necessity that if they desire to continue to receive electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service, they shall provide, at their own expense, all necessary

facility changes on their premises so as to receive underground service from the lines relocated underground of the supplying utility company subject to applicable rules, regulations and tariffs of the respective utility company on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California as of the date of adoption of this resolution and subject to all other applicable requirements of State law and City ordinances. The Clerk's notification shall be made in the manner provided in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code.

4. The City Council hereby finds that the underground utility district created herein is required by the public health, safety and general welfare for the following reason:

Streets, roads or right of ways adjoin or pass through a public recreation area.


