WHEREAS, after two and one-half years of study, there has been introduced for adoption by the State Legislature Assembly Bill 813 which culminates a two-year study and recommendation by a special committee of the League of California Cities; and

WHEREAS, there is a dire need for a thorough overhauling of the existing State annexation laws; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of the proposed legislation would be especially beneficial to cities as it relates to the annexation of unincorporated islands surrounded by a city or cities; and

WHEREAS, the enactment of this bill will enable the cities to proceed in a more orderly manner toward the handling of uninhabited annexations; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Council of The City of San Diego strongly urges the State Legislature to enact Assembly Bill 813 thereby providing significant relief to the cities of the State of California.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to forward copies of this resolution to the members of the Committee on Local Government, to the Governor, and to the local legislative representatives of San Diego.
