RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CANVASS OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON JUNE 8, 1971.

WHEREAS, this Council by Ordinance No. 10544 (New Series) adopted April 8, 1971, called a Special Municipal Election to be held in the City on June 8, 1971; and

WHEREAS, this Special Municipal Election was duly consolidated with the County Special Election and the San Diego Unified School District Election held upon the same date; and

WHEREAS, the Special Municipal Election was held on June 8, 1971 for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the City the following proposition:

PROPOSITION L. SOLICITING THE OPINION OF THE PEOPLE OF SAN DIEGO ON THE QUESTION: Shall the City Council of The City of San Diego consider calling an election on the question "Shall a Charter Commission be elected to propose a new charter or to revise the current charter?"?

WHEREAS, a copy of the certificate of the Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego canvassing the returns of the Special Municipal Election, including absentee votes cast, as certified to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, has been duly received; and

WHEREAS, a canvass of the Special Municipal Election has been completed and the City Clerk has certified the results to the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Council finds and determines pursuant to the provisions of Section 27.2206 of the San Diego Municipal Code, as follows:

- 1. The total number of votes cast in the City, including absentee votes, is 136,098.
- 2. The number of votes, including absentee votes, cast for and against the proposition which appeared on the ballot as proposition lettered L and the total number of the votes cast upon the proposition, including absentee votes, are as follows:

PROPOSITION L:

For 34,746

Against 89,325

Total 124,071

3. Proposition L was not approved by the vote of a majority of the qualified voters voting on it and such proposition is hereby declared to have failed.

- 4. The number of votes cast, including absentee votes, is recorded in the Election Returns Book, which book is a part of the records of this Council.
- 5. The City Clerk shall make public the results of the canvass of the Special Municipal Election by publication of a copy of this resolution.
