

RESOLUTION NO. 203246

Adopted on JUL 27 1971

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

George N. Wheeldon	POLICE DEPARTMENT	\$1,000	Changes in the procedures for handling the impounding of abandoned vehicles were proposed. Council action was necessary to make the suggester legally able to perform some of the impounding functions. He also proposed a reorganization of duties so that beat officers are relieved of all impounding functions, this saving the equivalent of one full time officer.
Larry J. Munsterman	POLICE DEPARTMENT	\$700	During the suggester's temporary special assignment at the City Pound, he observed that owners of unlicensed dogs involved in biting cases were not being effectively required to obtain licenses. He developed a complete new procedure which greatly increased license revenue to the City. Substantial savings were also made in the handling of dog bite cases. The savings were enjoyed by the City until April 1, 1971 when the County took over the operation of the Pound, amounting to \$7000
Rodney G. Stone	PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT Equipment Division	\$150	The suggester, a Welder in the Equipment Division, made many repairs on the hopper tubes on Heil refuse packers. He designed a part to be added to this equipment to prevent wear at an area. This slight additional expense prevents substantial and regular maintenance costs for a much longer period. The net saving is estimated to be \$1,500 a year.
