

RESOLUTION No. 203327

Adopted on AUG 3 1971

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the bid of \$66,290.00 by DBX, Inc. dba Perry Electric, A Corporation, for the CONSTRUCTION OF SAFETY LIGHTING AND TRAFFIC SIGNAL SYSTEMS AT COLUMBIA STREET AND GRAPE STREET, GRAMERCY DRIVE AND SANDROCK ROAD AT GREYLING DRIVE, AND CAMINO DE LA REINA AND MISSION CENTER ROAD, consisting of the Base Bid of \$63,807.00 plus Additive Alternate "A" (Items 8 through 10) for the sum of \$4,033.00, less Deductive Alternate "A" (Item 11) for the sum of \$1,550.00 in the City of San Diego, California, is hereby accepted; and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract therefor in accordance with the form on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 736227.
2. That the expenditure of \$78,200.00 is hereby authorized out of the Gas Tax Fund (219) of the City of San Diego solely and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for CONSTRUCTION OF SAFETY LIGHTING AND TRAFFIC SIGNAL SYSTEMS AT COLUMBIA STREET AND GRAPE STREET, GRAMERCY DRIVE AND SANDROCK ROAD AT GREYLING DRIVE, AND CAMINO DE LA REINA AND MISSION CENTER ROAD, consisting of the Base Bid of \$63,807.00 plus Additive Alternate "A" (Items 8 through 10) for the sum of \$4,033.00, less Deductive Alternate "A" (Item 11) for the sum of \$1,550.00 in the City of San Diego, and related costs.
