BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the bid of \$33,227.00 by Wilcox Electric, Inc. dba Arrow Electric, a corporation for the CONSTRUCTION OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS & SAFETY LIGHTING SYSTEMS AT THE INTERSECTION OF MISSION VILLAGE DRIVE AND SHAWN AVENUE AND MEDIAN STRIP PAVING ON SHAWN AVENUE FROM MELBOURNE DRIVE TO MARATHON DRIVE including Additive "A" Items 4 and 5, in the City of San Diego, California is hereby accepted; and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract therefor in accordance with the form on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 736912.
2. That the expenditure of \$38,250.00 is hereby authorized out of the Gas Tax Fund 220 of the City of San Diego solely and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for the CONSTRUCTION OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS & SAFETY LIGHTING SYSTEMS AT THE INTERSECTION OF MISSION VILLAGE DRIVE AND SHAWN AVENUE AND MEDIAN STRIP PAVING ON SHAWN AVENUE FROM MELBOURNE DRIVE TO MARATHON DRIVE including Additive "A" Items 4 and 5, in the City of San Diego, and related costs.
