RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE MUNICIPAL PRIMARY ELECTION AND THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND IN THE SAN DIEGO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT ON SEPTEMBER 21, 1971.

WHEREAS, a municipal primary election was held in the City of San Diego and the San Diego Unified School District on Tuesday, the twenty-first day of September, 1971, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 10628 (New Series) for the purpose of nominating candidates; and

WHEREAS, a special municipal election was held in the City of San Diego on the same date, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 10629 (New Series) which special election was consolidated with the municipal primary election for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the City of San Diego a proposition to amend the Charter of The City of San Diego, as follows:

PROPOSITION A. CITY OF SAN DIEGO CHARTER
AMENDMENT: AMEND SECTION 12 OF THE
CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

Amend Section 12 to provide that Councilmen shall not engage in any business or transaction or have a financial or other personal interest, direct or indirect, which is incompatible with the proper discharge of their duties or which would tend to impair their independence of judgment or action in the performance of such duties, and that the rate of pay for each Councilman shall be Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars per month.

and

WHEREAS, a copy of the certificate of the Registrar of Voters of San Diego County canvassing the returns of the municipal primary election and the special municipal election, as certified to the City Clerk, has been duly received; and

WHEREAS, a canvass of these elections has been completed and the City Clerk has certified the results to the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Council finds and determines, pursuant to the provisions of Section 27.2206 of the San Diego Municipal Code, as follows:

I

The whole number of votes cast in the City was 159,799.

II

The whole number of votes cast in the San Diego Unified School District was 87,518.

III

The total vote received by each municipal candidate and each candidate for the Board of Education of the San Diego Unified School District at the municipal primary election is as follows:


The number of votes in each precinct cast for each person and for and against each measure are recorded in the Election Returns Book, which book is a part of the records of this Council.
