WHEREAS, the public interest or necessity demands the immediate expenditure of public money to safeguard life, health or property by reason of said damage; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the offer of Fluor Ocean Services, Inc. is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract for REPAIRS TO THE WEST MISSION BAY DRIVE BRIDGE for a total cost not to exceed \$4,239.
