WHEREAS, The City of San Diego has entered into an agreement with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for a grant to carry out a Model Cities Program with a budget of \$6,600,000; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the First Action Year will be extended by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, certain budget changes will be necessary to finance Model Cities' projects through the remainder of the First Action Year; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized, subject to HUD approval, to make such monetary transfers as from time to time are deemed necessary from unexpended Model Cities' funds and among the Model Cities' projects and operations provided that the total funds expended shall not exceed the grant amount of \$6,600,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that each Model Cities' operating agency be notified of any adjustments made in their appropriation and that all changes made thereof shall be in accordance with the terms of their agreements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized to extend the termination date of all Model Cities' projects to coincide with the end of the First Action Year.
