AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 10450 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED DECEMBER 1, 1970, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ESTABLISHING A PARKING AND BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT AREA AND LEVYING AN ADDITIONAL BUSINESS LICENSE TAX THEREIN FOR UPGRADING AND PROMOTING THE AREA."

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 10450 (New Series), adopted December 1, 1970, be and it is hereby amended by amending Section 3 to read as follows:

Section 3. That in addition to the general business license tax, an additional business license tax is hereby imposed upon businesses located within said Area. The additional license tax shall be as follows:

Class A: No increase

Business of Manufacturing
Business of Wholesale
Public Utilities (Gas & Electric,
Telephone & Water)

Class B: An amount equal to two times the present business license tax, provided that the amount to be collected from any person, regardless of number of separate business licenses held at one location, would not exceed \$50 plus \$4 per employee per year.

Class C:

An amount equal to the present business license tax, provided that the amount to be collected from any person, regardless of the number of separate business licenses held at one location, would not exceed \$25 plus \$2 per employee per year, and that if a person was engaged in business activities requiring licenses under both Class B and Class C, the maximum additional

business license tax specified in Class B would apply and would be collected at one time each year.

All other businesses not enumerated in Class A or Class B above.

Said additional license tax shall be levied, collected and enforced in the same manner, at the same times, and with the same penalties and interest as in the case of the general business license tax.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
