AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER V,
ARTICLE 3 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL
CODE BY REPEALING SECTIONS 53.01.2
AND 53.05 AND AMENDING SECTIONS 53.01
AND 53.01.1, ALL RELATING TO USE OF
EXPLOSIVES FOR BLASTING.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of
San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter V, Article 3 of the
San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby
amended by repealing Sections 53.01.2 and 53.05.

Section 2. That Chapter V, Article 3 of the
San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby
amended by amending Sections 53.01 and 53.01.1 to read
as follows:

SEC. 53.01 BLASTING--PERMIT REQUIRED

It shall be unlawful for any person or
persons, firm or corporation to do any blasting
within the corporate limits of the City of
San Diego without first having obtained, from the
Fire Chief of The City of San Diego, a permit,
which is required under California Health and Safety
Code, Section 12101. The Fire Chief of The City of
San Diego is hereby designated the issuing authority
in conformance with California Health and Safety
Code, Section 12007.

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SEC. 53.01.1 BLASTING--APPLICATION FOR LICENSE--
INSURANCE REQUIRED.

Any applicant to the San Diego Fire Department for a permit for the use of explosives within the limits of the City of San Diego for blasting, as provided above, shall, before such permit is issued, have a policy of insurance approved by the City Attorney, executed and delivered by a reliable insurance company authorized to carry on an insurance business in the State of California, by the terms of which said insurance company assumes responsibility for injuries to persons and property resulting by reason of the use of such explosives by applicant in the following amounts; to wit,

Bodily Injury	\$250,000 --	Per person
	500,000 --	Per occurrence
Property Damage	250,000 --	Per occurrence.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows: Section 1. That Chapter V, Article 3 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by repealing Sections 53.012 and 53.05.

SEC 101.1 BLASTING—PERMIT REQUIRED. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to be blasting within the corporate limits of the City of San Diego, hereinafter having obtained the approval of the Chief of the City of San Diego, which approval shall be given only after the applicant has obtained the approval of the California Health and Safety Code, Section 2101. The City of San Diego hereby designated the issuing authority to conformance with California Health and Safety Code, Section 2101.

APPLICATION FOR LICENSURE AND INSURANCE REQUIRED.

Any applicant to the San Diego Police Department for a permit for use of explosives within the limits of the City of San Diego, shall, before such permit is issued, have a policy of insurance approved by the City Attorney, executed and delivered by a reliable insurance company authorized to carry on an insurance business in the State of California by the terms of which said insurance company assumes responsibility for injuries to persons and property resulting by reason of the use of such explosives by applicant in the following amounts, to wit:

Bodily Injury	\$250,000
—Per person	500,000
—Per occurrence	500,000
Property Damage	250,000
—Per occurrence	250,000

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
