AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 4,
DIVISION 1 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE
BY AMENDING SECTION 24.0103(f) RELATING TO
DEFINITION OF SAFETY MEMBERS.

WHEREAS, the Freeholders Charter of The City of San Diego establishing the Police Relief and Pension Fund and the Firemen's Relief and Pension Fund set forth eligibility criteria for membership in the respective funds; and

WHEREAS, the above-mentioned funds were combined in 1947; and

WHEREAS, the eligibility requirements originally established were continued in full force and effect upon incorporation in 1955 as new Article X of the Charter of The City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, such personnel have since been and are presently designated as "safety members" of the City Employees' Retirement System; and

WHEREAS, since the inception of the Retirement System of The City of San Diego the term "safety member" has acquired, through definition, application and interpretation of pertinent Charter provisions and ordinances promulgated pursuant thereto, a well-defined meaning and status; and

WHEREAS, qualification for membership as a "safety member" in the Retirement System of The City of San Diego has required and presently requires duties consisting of full-time active

law enforcement, full-time active fire suppression, or performance as a full-time lifeguard; and

WHEREAS, it is contemplated that a reassignment of duties may be effected to establish deputized positions for limited purposes only; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable at this time to more clearly define the term "safety member" so that no ambiguity in regard to eligibility criteria as a safety member be created by such contemplated action as hereinabove set forth; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 4, Division 1 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 24.0103(f) to read as follows:

SEC. 24.0103(f)

"Safety Member" means any person who is either a regular sworn officer of the Police Department of the City of San Diego employed since July 1, 1946, a uniformed member of the Fire Department of the City of San Diego employed since July 1, 1946, or a full-time employed lifeguard of the City of San Diego; provided, however, that Police Cadets, persons sworn for limited purposes only, and all other members of the Police and Fire

Departments and Lifeguard Service shall not be considered
Safety Members for the purposes of this ordinance.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in
force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.



WHEREAS, it is contemplated that assignment of duties may be extended to establish deputized positions for limited purposes only; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable at this time to more clearly define the term "safety member" so that no ambiguity in regard to eligibility criteria as a safety member be created by such contemplated action as hereinabove set forth; NOW

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows: Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 4, Division 1 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 24.0103(f) to read as follows:
SEC. 24.0103(f)

"Safety Member" means any person who is either a regular sworn officer of the Police Department of the City of San Diego employed since July 1, 1946, a uniformed member of the Fire Department of the City of San Diego employed since July 1, 1946, or a full-time employed lifeguard of the City of San Diego; provided, however, that Police Cadets, persons sworn for limited purposes only, and all other members of the Police and Fire Departments and Lifeguard Service shall not be considered Safety Members for the purposes of this ordinance.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
