

ORDINANCE NO. 10842  
(New Series)

MAY 25 1972

AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING A PORTION OF RANCHO SAN BERNARDO, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, INTO CA-S ZONE, AS DEFINED BY SECTION 101.0428 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 8766 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED DECEMBER 6, 1962, OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO INSOFAR AS THE SAME CONFLICTS HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That in the event that, within two years of the effective date of this ordinance, a portion of Rancho San Bernardo, in the City of San Diego, California, designated "CA-S" on Zone Map Drawing No. B-2615.1, is subdivided and a final subdivision map or maps thereof duly recorded and within such subdivision or subdivisions, provision is made for the installation of public utility services and the dedication of streets, alleys and easements for public use, the provisions of Section 101.0428 of the San Diego Municipal Code shall attach and become applicable to the said subdivided land and the said subdivided land shall be incorporated into CA-S Zone, as described by Section 101.0428, the boundary of such zone to be as indicated on Zone Map Drawing No. B-2615.1, filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 739667. Said zoning shall attach only to those areas included in the subdivision map or maps recorded as provided in this section.

Section 2. That in the event the zoning restrictions shall attach to the said land described in Section 1 of this ordinance, Ordinance No. 8766 (New Series), adopted December 6, 1962, of the Ordinances of The City of San Diego be, and it is hereby repealed insofar as it conflicts herewith.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE VI, DIVISION 3 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 66.20.12 RELATING TO DOGS ON CITY BEACHES.**

WHEREAS, in order to promote the health and welfare of the citizens of the City of San Diego, the Council of the City of San Diego is hereby amending the City Code, NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

Section 66.20.12 of the San Diego Municipal Code relating to Dogs on City Beaches shall be amended to read as follows:

**SECTION 66.20.12 - DOGS ON CITY BEACHES**

A. Notwithstanding any other provision of this code, no person shall allow any dog, whether licensed or unlicensed, upon any public beach in the City between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. when such dog is not on a leash or having such leash attached to controls of the animal, except on areas which are to be used as such beach areas during the above specified hours. After 6:00 p.m. and until 6:00 a.m. the provisions of Section 66.20.12 shall apply.

B. The provisions of this section shall not apply to dogs which have been specially trained for and are used as guide dogs for the blind while such dogs are being used for such purpose.

C. The provisions of this section shall not apply to Fiesta Island in Mission Bay Park or to the beach area at the west end of the San Diego River Fluveway also known as the Ocean Beach Flood Control Channel.

D. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this code, legally licensed dogs shall be allowed, unlicensed in the two areas described in subsection C above, which areas are more specifically shown outlined in red on that map on file with the Office of the City Clerk of the City of San Diego as Document No. 10061.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day after its passage, promulgated on May 16, 1972, passed and approved by the Council of the City of San Diego on May 16, 1972.
