ORDINANCE NO. 10957 DEC 5 1972

AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING LOT 1, HOLIDAY VISTA, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, INTO CA ZONE, AS DEFINED BY SECTION 101.0428.1 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 8503 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED AUGUST 10, 1961, OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO INSOFAR AS THE SAME CONFLICTS HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Lot 1, Holiday Vista, in the City of San Diego, California, within the boundary of the district designated "CA" on Zone Map Drawing No. B-2639, filed in the office of the City Clerk under Document No. 740706 be, and it is hereby incorporated into CA Zone, as such zone is described and defined by Section 101.0428.1 of the San Diego Municipal Code.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 8503 (New Series), adopted August 10, 1961, of the Ordinances of The City of San Diego be, and it is hereby repealed insofar as the same conflicts herewith.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
