AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT BUILDING PERMITS ISSUED DURING THE PERIOD AUGUST 1, 1972, THROUGH MAY 31, 1973, NOT EXPIRE UNTIL OCTOBER 1, 1973, IF COMMENCEMENT OF WORK IS DELAYED PENDING DETERMINATION BY THE SAN DIEGO COAST REGIONAL COMMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR A DEVELOPMENT PERMIT, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 27104 AND 27400 OF THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That building permits issued during the period August 1, 1972, through May 31, 1973, not expire for failure to commence work until October 1, 1973, if commencement of work is delayed pending determination by the San Diego Coast Regional Commission of an application for a Development Permit, pursuant to Sections 27104 and 27400 of the California Public Resources Code.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
