RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO UNDER THE SPECIAL ASSESSMENT INVESTIGATION, LIMITATION AND MAJORITY PROTEST ACT OF 1931, DETERMINING THE GENERAL NATURE, LOCATION AND EXTENT OF THE PROPOSED WORK, GRANTING THE PETITION, AND ORDERING THE PREPARATION OF A REPORT ON SAID IMPROVEMENT.

(West Muirlands Drive Underground District No. 1)

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

- 1. That certain improvements are proposed to be done and made within the boundaries of the proposed assessment district, hereinafter described, within the boundaries of the City. In connection therewith, the City Council hereby finds and determines as follows:
 - a. That the nature of the proposed improvement is the construction of street lighting facilities, the removal of existing overhead electric and communication facilities and the replacement thereof by the construction of underground electric and communication facilities on and in portions of the public rights of way of WEST MUIRLANDS DRIVE, AVENIDA MANANA, NAUTILUS STREET and MUIRLANDS VISTA WAY, all within Muirlands Village No. 1, Muirlands Terrace Nos. 1 and 2, and a portion of Pueblo Lot No. 1257, in the City of San Diego, and the removal of existing overhead electric communication facilities and the replacement thereof by the construction

of underground electric and communication facilities upon various private lots and parcels adjoining and near the above-described streets, as shown on the plat of WEST MUIRLANDS DRIVE UNDERGROUND DISTRICT NO. 1, which plat is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 739248 and is open to public inspection.

- b. That the boundaries or extent of the district or lands proposed to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses of said proposed work and improvement are as shown upon said plat of WEST MUIRLANDS DRIVE UNDERGROUND DISTRICT NO. 1, Document No. 739248, which is on file in the office of the City Clerk and open to public inspection; and said plat shall govern for all details as to the extent of said assessment district.
- c. That the City Council further determines that the entire cost of said work is to be assessed upon said district and no amount or percentage of the cost is to be paid toward the cost of the improvement from any source other than the special assessments upon benefited properties.

- d. That the statute under which it is proposed to conduct proceedings is the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913 (commencing with Section 10000 of the Streets and Highways Code), with improvement bonds to be issued as authorized under the provisions of the Improvement Act of 1911.
- 2. That the petition for the above-described improvement consisting of three sheets and filed under Document No. 739249 is hereby granted.
- 3. That the City Manager is hereby directed to cause an investigation to be made of all necessary information to prepare, and to have prepared, a report of the proposed improvement in the manner and form as provided for in Division 4 of the Streets and Highways Code; and that said report shall, as a part thereof, contain a copy of this resolution.
