RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO REQUESTING THE CONSOLIDATION OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON JUNE 2, 1972, WITH THE STATEWIDE PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE SAME DATE.

WHEREAS, this Council intends to call a special election to be held on June 6, 1972, for the purpose of submitting to the voters of the City two propositions as set forth in this resolution to amend the Charter of The City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby requested to consolidate the special municipal election to be held in the City of San Diego on June 6, 1972, with the Statewide Primary Election to be held on the same date, for the purpose of amending the Charter of The City of San Diego.
- 2. The form of the two propositions to be voted upon at this special municipal election and as they are to appear on the ballot is as follows:

PROPOSITION . CITY OF SAN DIEGO CHARTER AMENDMENT. ADDS SECTION 103.1a TO THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

Shall an Environmental Growth Fund be created which sets aside twenty-five (25) percent of revenues collected from franchises for the transmission and distribution of gas, electricity and steam to be used two-thirds for debt service on bonds of any nature which are subsequently authorized to acquire open space for park or recreational purposes and the remaining for the preservation and enhancement of the environment of the City of San Diego? If no such bonds are subsequently issued, the entire Environmental Growth Fund must be used exclusively for the preservation and enhancement of the environment of the City of San Diego.

Each of the propositions shall be designated on the ballot by a letter printed on the left margin of the square containing the description of the measure as provided in Section 10231 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

- 3. The Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of this special municipal election and is requested to conduct the elections in all respects as if there were only one election using only one form of ballot.
- 4. The Board of Supervisors is hereby requested to issue to all officers of the County charged with duties pertaining to the Statewide Primary Election, instructions to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of the consolidated election.
- 5. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and the Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego.
