RESOLUTION NO. Conditional Use Permit No. 331-PC

WHEREAS, PERRY D. EDSON, HENRY L. and SYLVIA WILSON, and AGNES SYNEK, individuals, Owner, and SHELL OIL COMPANY, a Delaware corporation, Permittee, filed an application for a conditional use permit to construct and operate a service station with accessory sales, located on the west side of Euclid Avenue, between State Highway 94 and Hilltop Drive, being a portion of Lot 29, Horton's Purchase of Ex-Mission Lands, more particularly described in Appendix "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof, in the R-1-5 Zone; and

WHEREAS, on February 2, 1972, the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego made its findings of facts, which are set forth in Resolution No. 331-PC, and denied Conditional Use Permit No. 331-PC, to Permittee for the construction and operation of said service station, and filed said decision in the office of the City Clerk on February 18, 1972; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 101.0506 of the San Diego Municipal Code, PERRY D. EDSON, INC., by Paul A. Peterson, attorney, under date of February 15, 1972, appealed the decision of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, said appeal was set for public hearing on March 30, 1972, testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted and the City Council having fully considered the matter and being

fully advised concerning the same; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

All of the following facts exist with respect to the denial of said Conditional Use Permit No. 331-PC on the property described in the preamble of this resolution.

- 1. The proposed use at the particular location is not necessary or desirable to provide a facility which will contribute to the general well-being of the community.
- 2. Such use will, under the circumstances of the particular case, be detrimental to the health, safety or general welfare of persons residing or working in the vicinity, or injurious to property or improvements in the vicinity.
- 3. The proposed use will not comply with the regulations and conditions specified in the Code for such use.
- 4. The granting of this conditional use will adversely affect the Southeast San Diego Community Plan, the General Plan of the City and the adopted plan of any governmental agency.

The above findings are further supported by the minutes, tape of the proceedings, maps and exhibits, all of which are herein incorporated by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that by a vote of 7 to 2, the appeal of PERRY D. EDSON, INC., by Paul A. Peterson, attorney, is hereby denied; and the decision of the Planning Commission denying Conditional Use Permit No. 331-PC be, and it is hereby upheld.
