BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept the proposal of Wainwright & Ramsey, municipal finance consultants, to develop a series of water rate designs reflecting the impact of transferring Metropolitan Water District and San Diego County Water Authority taxes from water revenues to the property tax in the manner and for the compensation set forth in that letter dated March 25, 1972, from Wainwright and Ramsey, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 739576

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Auditor is hereby authorized to transfer \$17,500 within the Water Operating Fund 500 Reserve (67.49-3495) to Professional Services (67.27-3295) solely and exclusively for the above mentioned purpose.
