BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the offer of Global Moving and Storage is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract for the SERVICE OF TRANSPORTING FROM WASHINGTON, D.C. TO SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA THE FAMILY HOUSEHOLD GOODS OF JOHN WITZEL, LEGISLATIVE REPRESENTATION DIRECTOR, for a total estimated cost of \$3,056.60.
2. Authorizing the payment of family travel expenses of John Witzel, Legislative Representation Director, for an estimated cost of \$760.00; and,
3. Authorizing the appropriation of \$3,860.00 from the General Fund (100), Department 53.30, Unallocated Reserve, and transferring this amount to the General Fund (100), Department 4.60, Non-Personal Expense, for the above purposes.
