RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE OPERATION OF THE SAN DIEGO MODEL CITIES SENIOR CITIZENS PROJECT BY THE RECREATION DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego, California, has entered into a contract with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to carry out, within the City of San Diego, a Model Cities Program; and

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Demonstration Plan for the Second Action Year, the form of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 738811, authorized by Resolution No. 204770, and adopted January 27, 1972, was approved by HUD on April 6, 1972; and

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Demonstration Plan, Second
Action Year, designates The City of San Diego as the operating
agency for the Senior Citizens Project, hereinafter called
"Project;" and

WHEREAS, the Grant Agreement referred to in the first recital herein provides supplemental grant funds for the operation of said Project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The City Manager of The City of San Diego be, and he is hereby authorized to assume full responsibility for the successful implementation and completion of Project in accordance with the Grant Agreement between The City of San Diego and HUD, along with appurtenant

regulations, and in accordance with the terms and conditions as they may apply as set forth in Document No. 738536, on file in the office of the City Clerk.

- 2. The operation of the Project and costs incurred thereto shall be no more liberal than policies, procedures and practices applied uniformly to both federally assisted and other activities of the City.
- 3. The City shall operate Project in a manner consistent with the Project Work Program Cover Sheet, attached hereto as Exhibit A; Project Work Program, attached hereto as Exhibit B; and the itemized Program Budget, attached hereto as Exhibit C; provided, however, that if Project is not being reasonably maintained in accordance with its work schedule and budget expenditures, the Manager shall be and he is hereby authorized to initiate appropriate revisions to the department's budget in line with actual budget expenditures either by deletion or addition, thereby minimizing the amount of unexpended program funds remaining at the end of the action year.
- 4. The City Auditor shall be and he is hereby authorized to transfer \$150,000 from the Model Cities Second Action Year Fund 2902 of The City of San Diego to

Fund 2545 of the Recreation Department to be used by said
Department and accounted for separately, solely and
exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for the
operation of Project.

PROJECT WORK PROGRAM COVER SHEET

SENIOR CITIZEN'S PROJECT

<u>General Purpose</u>: The general purpose of this program is to provide a variety of services to Senior Citizens for the purpose of providing healthy, happier, more productive lives.

Scope of Services:

- A. The program will provide for an augmented staff structure by:
 - 1. Writing 5 new job descriptions.
 - 2. Advertising 9 vacancies.
 - 3. Interviewing 30 MNR applicants.
 - 4. Hiring 9 new staff members including 1 Director, 1 Stenographer, 3 Center Managers and 4 Center Workers.
 - 5. Conduct continuous staff training for the professional staff at 6 hours per month.
- B. Additionally the program will provide part-time employment of Senior Citizens by:
 - 1. Writing 4 job descriptions for 22 positions for part-time staff.
 - 2. Advertising for 22 part-time positions.
 - 3. Interviewing at least 44 Senior Citizens for the 22 part-time positions.
 - 4. Hiring Senior Citizens for 22 part-time positions.
 - 5. Conducting 20 hours orientation training for part-time staff.
 - 6. Conducting 1 hour per week of continuous staff training for part-time staff.
- C. The project will provide home recreation for shut-ins by:
 - 1. Developing a plan for activities by June 30, 1972.
 - 2. Implementing the recreation plan by July, 1972.
 - 3. Upgrading the plan quarterly.
- D. The project will provide counseling services for Senior Citizens as needed in areas of health, social security information, welfare information, and consumer education.
- E. The project will provide 6,000 hot meals to Senior Citizens each month (1 hot meal per day per person) phasing from catering services to meals prepared by Senior Citizens who are part-time employees; phasing to be completed by May 31, 1972.

- F. The project will continue to provide center recreation for Senior Citizens through:
 - 1. One out of town trip per month.
 - Four community interest trips per month.
 - 3. Quiet and semi-active games daily.
 - 4. Square dancing weekly.
- G. In the interest of program expansion, the project will:
 - 1. Develop a plan for implementing medical services; plans to be produced by June 30, 1972.
 - 2. Continue program for construction of a Senior Citizen Center by developing a plan for implementation by September, 1972.
- H. To foster confidence and change in attitudes about Social Conditions of Senior Citizens the project will advertise and promote activities and achievements of the Senior Citizen project by:
 - 1. Holding four 2-hour workshops per month advertising the program.
 - 2. Establishing coordination to syndicate the Senior Citizens column in two weeklies and two daily San Diego newspapers.
 - 3. Speaking to community organizations on the Senior Citizen project.
 - A. 1 church group/month
 - B. 1 business group/month
 - C. 1 social club/month

<u>Time of Performance</u>: All services shall be completed by January 31, 1973.

<u>Citizen Advisory Board</u>: The Citizens Advisory Council is made up of a Senior Citizen representative from each Model Cities Area. Each has an alternate back-up. The council meets the first Wednesday of each month.

Obtaining Separate Funds: The project is required to search out and apply for non-Model Cities funds through assistance of Model Cities Planning Staff. Contract renewal in 1973 if deemed desirable by CDA will be contingent in part on the agency's efforts to obtain other funding.
