A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE OPERATION OF THE SAN DIEGO MODEL CITIES RELOCATION PROJECT BY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPART-MENT OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego, California, has entered into a contract with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to carry out, within the City of San Diego, a Model Cities Program; and

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Demonstration Plan for the Second Action Year, the form of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 738811, authorized by Resolution No. 204770, and adopted January 27, 1972, was approved by HUD on April 6, 1972; and

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Demonstration Plan, Second Action Year designates The City of San Diego as the operating agency for the Relocation project, hereinafter called "Project;" and

WHEREAS, the Grant Agreement referred to in the first recital herein provides supplemental grant funds for the operation of said project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The City Manager of The City of San Diego be and he is hereby authorized to assume full responsibility for the successful implementation and completion of Project in accordance with the Grant Agreement between The City of San Diego and HUD along with appurtenant regulations and in accordance with the terms and conditions as they may apply as set forth in Document No. 738536, on file in the office of the City Clerk.
- 2. The operation of the Project and costs incurred thereto shall be no more liberal than policies, procedures and practices applied uniformly to both federally assisted and other activities of the City.
- 3. The City shall operate Project in a manner consistent with the Project Work Program Cover Sheet, attached hereto as Exhibit A; Project Work Program, attached hereto as Exhibit B; and the itemized Program Budget, attached hereto as Exhibit C; provided, however, that if Project is not being reasonably maintained in accordance with its work schedule and budget expenditures, the Manager shall be and he is hereby authorized to initiate appropriate revisions to the department's budget in line with actual budget expenditures either by deletion or addition, thereby minimizing the amount of unexpended program funds remaining at the end of the action year.

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4. The City Auditor shall be and he is hereby authorized to transfer \$190,600.00 from the Model Cities Second Action Year Fund No. 2902 of The City of San Diego to Fund No. 2548 of the Community Development Department to be used by said Department and accounted for separately, solely and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for the operation of Project.

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### PROJECT WORK PROGRAM COVER SHEET

### RELOCATION PROJECT

General Purpose: To relocate families, individuals and businesses displaced by physical or capital improvement projects identified in the Model Cities Second Action Year Plan and to provide benefits presented by the Federal government's Relocation Law to these displacees.

Scope of Services: The Community Development Department, Centralized Relocation Division will hire and train by April 31, 1972:

- a) One (1) bilingual relocation aide.
- b) One (1) bilingual intermediate typist.

The Model Cities Relocation staff hired for this activity will be providing assistance and payments required by law to eligible displacees under the following programs:

- 1. CODE ENFORCEMENT: A person shall be deemed displaced by Code Enforcement under the Model Cities Program if the vacating of the real property occurs as a result of abatement action taken by the City Housing Inspection Department against the residence, because the condition of the house is not in compliance with City Housing Codes, and requires extensive repair or demolition and necessitates the resident's move. If the rehabilitation of the premise does not necessitate a move but does cause a rent increase of 25% for a business or 10% for a family or individual and the resulting rent is over the ability-to-pay standards for families and individuals, tenants will be eligible for relocation assistance.
- 2. NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION: San Diego Neighborhood Development Corporation under the auspices of the Model Cities Non-Profit Housing and Factory Produced Housing Programs is acquiring properties in the Model Neighborhood and converting some sub-standard housing into standard single family units. These endeavors are a material part of the Model Cities Program and displaced families, individuals and businesses are therefore eligible for relocation assistance.
- 3. ANY OTHER MODEL CITIES PROGRAMS: Displacees of land-acquisition activities caused by other programs deemed to be a material part of the Model Cities Plan will be afforded relocation assistance and payments where prescribed by law. Specifically funded for the Second Action Year is the Comprehensive Health Facility. Other programs will be identified as the Second Action Year progresses.

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**EXHIBIT A** 

The purpose of these programs is to improve the quality of housing in the Model Neighborhood and to provide persons currently living in sub-standard units, with assistance in finding standard rentals or homes. In addition, relocation assistance will be provided to businesses displaced by Model Cities projects.

- 4. In order to carry out this activity, Agency's Model Cities staff will:
  - a) Interview eligible displacees.
  - b) Relocate eligible displacees and provide followup payments where necessary.
  - c) Maintain up-to-date listing of resources from housing referral agencies.
  - d) Maintain relationship with displacing agencies to obtain relocation referrals.

Time of Performance: All services to be completed by January 31, 1973.

<u>Citizen Advisory Committee</u>: A Relocation and Grievance Committee will be established by the Model Cities Director with the advice of the Citizens' Advisory Board.
