RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING A REPORT PREPARED PURSUANT TO THE MUNICIPAL IMPROVE-MENT ACT OF 1913; AND FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE FOR HEARING PROTESTS AND OBJECTIONS TO THE IMPROVEMENTS, DIAGRAM AND ASSESSMENT DESCRIBED AND CONTAINED IN THE REPORT AND WHETHER THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRES SUCH IMPROVEMENTS, AND GIVING NOTICE THEREOF

(Calle Del Cielo Assessment District)

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego adopted Resolution of Intention No. 205602, declaring its intention to order certain improvements under the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913 (commencing with Section 10000 of the Streets and Highways Code), referring the improvements described therein to the City Manager, directing the City Manager to make and file with the City Clerk a Report in writing containing all of the matters required by the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913; and

WHEREAS, said Report has been made and filed with the City Clerk, Document No. 739939, and the City Clerk has presented the Report to the Council for consideration; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17 of Article XIII of the Constitution of the State of California, Section 2804 of the Streets and Highways Code, and Sections 61.0101 to 61.0111, inclusive, of the San Diego Municipal Code, the Council proposes, after notice and hearing, to find and determine by no less than a four-fifths vote of all the members thereof, that the public convenience and necessity require the improvements and to order the improvements without application of the Special Assessment

Investigation, limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931 (commencing at Section 2800 of the Streets and Highways Code) and the debt limitation and majority protest provisions of said Act; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. The Council has considered and passed on the Report. The Report, as filed, is hereby approved. The Report, including the plans, estimate of costs and expenses, diagram and assessment incorporated therein by reference, is on file in the Office of the City Clerk and may be examined by any interested person. Reference is made to the plans for a full and detailed description of the proposed work.

Section 3. NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that at the abovementioned day, hour and place, and concurrently with the abovementioned hearing, the Council also will hold a public hearing
on the question whether the public convenience and necessity
require the improvements, and whether the Special Assessment
Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931 and
the debt limitation and majority protest provisions thereof
shall apply. Notice of the public hearing provided for by this
section shall be published, posted and mailed by the same means,
at the same time and in the same manner as for the hearing
provided by Section 2 of this resolution.

Section 4. The City Clerk is hereby directed to cause notices of the passage of this resolution to be posted, and is also directed to mail notices of the adoption of the Resolution of Intention and the filing of the Report, both of such notices to be given at the time and in the form and manner as provided by law.

Section 5. The City Clerk is further directed to cause a

______, a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in The City of San Diego, the first such publication to be made at least 20 days before the date set herein for the hearing of protests.
