WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego adopted Resolution No. 199516 urging the State Legislature to pass California Assembly Concurrent Resolution No. 81 providing for the establishing of a Joint Committee on Hastings College of Law for the purpose of analyzing and studying facts relating to the establishing of a second campus of the Hastings College of Law in the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the study, the feasibility of the campus in San Diego has been ascertained and the project approved; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Hastings College of Law has accepted the responsibility of creating the second campus in San Diego; and

WHEREAS, at the present time a request for appropriate appropriations to undertake the creation of the second campus in San Diego is pending in the Legislature and Assemblyman E. Richard Barnes is the responsible legislator; and

WHEREAS, expeditious funding of the project would be of great benefit to the City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego that the Assembly and Senate of the State of California are urged to appropriate at this time the funds needed for the founding of the second campus of the Hastings College of Law in the City of San Diego.
