Ethel B. Maxwell	WATER UTILITIES	\$95	A policy was proposed of notifying customers when their checks were returned by banks. In this way most field trips to shut off water have been eliminated as customers now can settle their accounts before shut-offs. This has saved a net of \$950 during the year.
Mary D. Bush	LIBRARY	\$85	The suggester proposed an electric buzzer lock for the rear door of the Library and a better personnel arrangement in relation to the rear entrance for deliveries and shipping. It is estimated that better utilization of two people saves \$842 a year.
George J. Malloy	POLICE DEPARTMENT	\$30	As proposed by this officer, the School District has agreed to pay the City \$283 a year for Police instruction in the driver training course.
Ralph H. Edwards	PARKS & PUBLIC BLDGS.	\$20	The use of epoxy cement to hold up conduit, pipes and other items in the corrosive air at the Treatment Plant weir room has stopped the maintenance expense resulting from the former use of metal supports.
Odilo A. Polinsky	FIRE DEPARTMENT	\$15	This Fireman suggested elimination of an electrical hazard at all fire stations in the emergency generator control panel by moving a switch outside the box. Exposure to shock was removed in this way.
