

RESOLUTION NO. 205947 JUN 27 1972

WHEREAS, the California Council on Criminal Justice may consent to review for possible funding the project submitted by The City of San Diego referred to as "Criminal Justice Teaching Position," at San Diego State University, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. 738977; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the City Manager is hereby directed to execute and submit to the California Council on Criminal Justice on behalf of said City, the application for grant for law enforcement purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in the event the California Council on Criminal Justice consents to fund the above project, The City of San Diego agrees to accept the grant and designates the City Manager to execute on behalf of said City the contract for the grant for law enforcement purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that The City of San Diego agrees to provide the required matching funds to said project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant ongoing law enforcement expenditures.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Resolution No. 204688 adopted January 19, 1972, be and the same is hereby rescinded.
