RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUNDS--SAN DIEGO BAY BIKE LOOP PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Congress under Public Law 88-578 has authorized the establishment of a Federal Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant-In-Aid Program providing matching funds to the State of California and its political subdivisions for acquiring lands and developing facilities for public outdoor recreation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Parks and Recreation is responsible for the administration of the program within the State, setting up necessary rules and procedures governing application by local agencies under the program; and

WHEREAS, said adopted procedures established by the State Department of Parks and Recreation require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of applications and the availability of local matching funds prior to submission of said applications to the State; and

WHEREAS, said procedures further require the applicant to possess an adopted plan showing parks and recreation lands and facilities, existing and proposed; and

WHEREAS, the City's Population Based Park Service Districts plan was first adopted by the City Council on April 27, 1971; and

WHEREAS, the proposed San Diego Bay Bike Loop project is consistent with the California Outdoor Recreation Resources Plan; and

WHEREAS, the project must be compatible with the land use plans of those jurisdictions immediately surrounding the project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized to execute and submit for and on behalf of The City of San Diego an application for Land and Water Conservation Fund assistance for use in connection with the proposed San Diego Bay Bike Loop project; and
- 2. That funds for the total amount of the proposed project, not to exceed \$80,000, are or will be available to said City for the financing of said project, half of which is to be reimbursed; and
- 3. That The City of San Diego meets all planning requirements and the proposed San Diego Bay Bike Loop project is compatible with the land use plans of those jurisdictions immediately surrounding the project; and
- 4. That the City Manager of The City of San Diego be and he is hereby appointed as the City's agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, billing
