

RESOLUTION NO. 206134

JUL 25 1972

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego has awarded six (6) nonexclusive franchises for the construction and operation of cable television systems in various areas within the City limits; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), by limiting carriage of signals from outside the San Diego market, in effect froze expansion of such systems beyond the geographical areas in which they were already in service on August 23, 1966, pending issuance by the FCC of comprehensive rules regulating CATV operations; and

WHEREAS, the FCC, after lengthy hearings at which representatives of all interested parties appeared and testified, on February 2, 1972, adopted its Cable Television Report and Order promulgating such rules; and

WHEREAS, cable television systems are required to obtain from the FCC certificates of compliance before they are permitted to expand their systems; and

WHEREAS, San Diego cable television franchise operators have applied to the Commission for such certificates and objections to the applications have been filed by two local broadcasters; and

WHEREAS, this Council believes that there is room in the San Diego market for all the existing television broadcasters and for cable systems serving all the citizens of the City; and

WHEREAS, failure or delay in issuing certificates of compliance to San Diego cable television systems may result in San Diego and its citizens being treated differently in respect to cable television than are other communities and their citizens nationwide; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

That the City Attorney, or his authorized representative, be
and he is hereby authorized to incur all necessary expenses in
connection with making the following views of this Council on the
subject of CATV known to the Federal Communications Commission:

1. This Council urges the Commission to continue to exercise
concern for the health of San Diego's local television broadcasters,
a concern evident in the cable television rules heretofore promulgated.

2. This Council urges the Commission to issue certificates of
compliance to those San Diego cable television systems applying for
them to the end that San Diego's citizens may receive the same level
of cable television service as is available in other American
communities of the same size.
