

RESOLUTION NO. 206240 AUG 8 1972

RESOLUTION CONSIDERING THE PROTESTS, ORDERING  
THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN ADDITIONAL TERRITORY  
INTO SAN DIEGO STREET LIGHTING MAINTENANCE  
DISTRICT NO. 1, AND AMENDING THE MAP.

(SAN DIEGO STREET LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 1)

WHEREAS, notice of the time and place fixed for the hearing of protests in the matter of the annexation of certain additional territory into San Diego Street Lighting Maintenance District No. 1 pursuant to Resolution of Intention No. 205972, adopted June 29, 1972, has been duly given in the manner required by law; and

WHEREAS, said hearing was held in accordance with Section 65.0218 of the San Diego Municipal Code with opportunity being given to all affected property owners to voice their objections and protests regarding the proposed annexation, and each such protest having been heard and considered; and

WHEREAS, this Council specifically finds that territory proposed to be annexed will benefit from such annexation; and that the San Diego Street Lighting Maintenance District No. 1 will not be adversely affected by the proposed annexation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the protests, if any, made in conjunction with the aforesaid annexation are hereby overruled and denied.

2. That the additional territory, the boundaries of which are generally described as:

- a. Emerald Hills Estates;
- b. Linda Vista Road (Genesee Avenue to Tait Street);
- c. Mission Boulevard (Pacific Beach Drive to Chalcedony Street);
- d. Stockton School Area;
- e. Scripps Ranch No. 3;
- f. North Miramar Ranch No. 2;

and more particularly described in the above referenced Resolution of Intention, as of this date is hereby ordered annexed into the San Diego Street Lighting Maintenance District No. 1.

3. That the map, designated as San Diego Street Lighting Maintenance District No. 1, consisting of 132 sheets, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 736278, be and the same is hereby amended by the addition of sheets Nos. 133 through 146 (Document No. 740419), to reflect said annexation; said map, as amended, is to govern as to all particulars.

4. That the maintenance described in the aforesaid Resolution of Intention is hereby ordered performed for the San Diego Street Lighting Maintenance District No. 1 (including the annexed territory).
