RESOLUTION REQUESTING AN ALLOCATION OF STATE PARTICIPATING FUNDS FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF A GRADE SEPARATION ON MIRAMAR ROAD AT THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY TRACK AND DECLARING THAT NECESSARY CITY MATCHING FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 205708.

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego has proposed the construction of a wider grade separation on Miramar Road at The Atchison,

Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company track; and

WHEREAS, it is required that the City furnish evidence to the California Department of Public Works that sufficient funds are available for the City's portion of the proposed work before an allocation of State funds is made; and

WHEREAS, said City certifies that all requirements of Section 190 of the Streets and Highways Code have been met, that Public Utilities Commission orders have been issued, necessary railroad agreements have been executed, sufficient local agency funds are available to finance one-half of the estimated cost of the project after first deducting the railroad contribution, and all other matters prerequisite to awarding the construction contract within six months have been or can be taken care of within that time; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the grade separation is estimated as follows:

TOTAL	\$250,000

WHEREAS, the amount of said total cost which is to be shared by the participating agencies is as follows:

The	AT&SF	Railway Company	\$	25,000
The	State	of California	\$1	.12,500
The	City	of San Diego	\$1	12.500

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the California Department of Public Works be requested to allocate \$112,500 in State funds under the provisions of Section 190 of the California Streets and Highways Code for the construction of the aforementioned grade separation in accordance with the aforesaid provisions and detailed information being submitted to the California Highway Commission by City through the State Division of Highways.
- 2. That funds are reserved for construction of the aforementioned grade separation under CIP No. 52-131.5 and scheduled for Fiscal Year 1971-72 in the Streets and Highways Section of The City of San Diego Capital Improvements Program
