RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO UNDER THE SPECIAL ASSESSMENT INVESTIGATION, LIMITA-TION AND MAJORITY PROTEST ACT OF 1931, GRANTING THE PETITION FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF AMALFI STREET AND TORREY LANE UNDER THE COMBINED TERMS OF THE CALI-FORNIA IMPROVEMENT ACTS OF 1911 AND 1913, AND DIRECTING THE PREPARATION OF A REPORT ON SAID IMPROVEMENT.

(AMALFI STREET ASSESSMENT DISTRICT)

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That certain improvements are proposed to be done and made within the boundaries of the proposed assessment district hereinafter described, within the boundaries of the City: In connection therewith, the Council hereby finds and determines as follows:
  - That the nature of the proposed improvement is the construction of street lighting facilities, the removal of existing overhead electric and communication facilities and the replacement thereof by the construction of underground electric and communication facilities on and in portions of the public rights of way of AMALFI STREET and TORREY LANE, and the removal of existing overhead electric and communication facilities and the replacement thereof by the construction of underground electric and communication facilities upon various private lots and parcels adjoining and near the above-described streets, as shown on the plat

- b. That the boundaries or extent of the district or lands proposed to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses of said proposed work and improvement are as shown upon said plat of 741001 Amalfi Street Assessment District, Document No. \_\_\_\_\_\_, which is on file in the office of the City Clerk and open to public inspection; and said plat shall govern for all details as to the extent of said assessment district.
- c. That the City Council further determines that the entire cost of said work is to be assessed upon said district and no amount or percentage of the cost is to be paid toward the cost of the improvement from any source other than the special assessments upon benefited properties.
- d. That the statute under which it is proposed to conduct proceedings is the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913 (commencing with Section 10000 of the Streets and Highways Code), with the improvement bonds to be issued as authorized under the provisions of the Improvement Act of 1911.
- 2. That the petition for the construction of certain improvements herein described on Amalfi Street and Torrey Lane under the combined provisions of the California Improvement Acts of 1911 and 1913, as amended, by the conversion of existing overhead power and communication facilities to an underground position within the public right of way and on private property, said petition consisting of two sheets, is hereby granted.

That the City Manager is hereby directed to cause an investigation to be made of all necessary information to prepare and to have prepared a report of the proposed improvements in the manner and form as provided for in Division 4 of the Streets and Highways Code, and that said report shall, as a part thereof, contain a copy of this resolution.
