RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO REQUESTING THE CONSOLIDATION OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL OPEN SPACE BOND ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY ON NOVEMBER 7, 1972, WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE SAME DATE.

MIEREAS, this Council has commenced proceedings and intends to call a special municipal bond election in the City to be held on November 7, 1972, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the City one general obligation open space bond proposition as set forth in this resolution; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that this special municipal bond election be consolidated with the statewide general election to be held on the same date and that within the City the election precincts, polling places, voting booths and election officials for the two elections be the same, and that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego be authorized to canvass the returns of the special municipal bond election, and that the statewide general election and this special municipal bond election be held in all respects as if there were only one election; and

WHEREAS, this Council within the time required by law has or will adopt an ordinance calling for a special municipal bond election and consolidating it with the statewide general election; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby requested to consolidate a special municipal bond election to be held in the City of San Diego on November 7, 1972, with the statewide general election to be held on the same date.
- 2. The exact form of the proposition to be voted upon at the special municipal bond election as such proposition shall appear on the ballot is as follows:

PROPOSITION . CITY OF SAN DIEGO OPEN SPACE BOND PROPOSITION.  The people of San Diego voted last June to create the Environmental Growth Fund to provide the monies to acquire open space from gas and electric franchise fees paid the City. Shall the City incur a general obligation bonded	YES	
indebtedness in the principal amount of Twenty-two Million Dollars (\$22,000,000) for the acquisition and improvement of open space for park and recreational purposes, pledging in payment of principal and interest thereon two-thirds of the Environmental Growth Fund created by Charter vote of the people for that purpose? The proposition shall be designated on the ballot by a letter printed on the left margin of the square containing the description of the measure as provided in Section 10231 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

3. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of this special municipal bond election and is requested to conduct the elections in all respects as if there were only one election using only one form of ballot.
