RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO
REQUESTING THE CONSOLIDATION OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL
ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON
NOVEMBER 7, 1972, WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL
ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE SAME DATE.

WHEREAS, this Council has or will call a special election
to be held on November 7, 1972, for the purpose of submitting
to the voters of the City one initiative measure and one other
measure as set forth in this resolution; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

1. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego
is hereby requested to consolidate the special municipal
election to be held for the purpose of submitting an initiative
measure and one other measure in the City of San Diego on
November 7, 1972, with the statewide general election to be
held on the same date.

2. The exact form of the two measures to be voted upon
at this special municipal election and as they are to appear
on the ballot is as follows:

PROPOSITION _____ . INITIATIVE MEASURE LIMITING THE HEIGHT OF BUILDINGS IN THE COASTAL ZONE IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO. Shall the people of the City of San Diego ordain that buildings to be built in the Coastal Zone shall be 30 feet or less in height? The Coastal Zone for this ordinance shall be that portion of the City west of Interstate 5, except the area bounded by National City on the south, San Diego Bay on the west and Laurel Street on the north. PROPOSITION _____ CITY OF SAN DIEGO LOW-INCOME HOUSING PROPOSAL FOR ELDERLY LOW-INCOME RESIDENTS.	YES	
Shall the Housing Authority of The City of San Diego develop, construct and acquire in the City of San Diego with Federal assistance, low rent housing specifically designed for elderly low-income residents, not to exceed a total of five hundred units, on scattered sites?	NO	

Each of the measures shall be designated on the ballot by a letter printed on the left margin of the square containing the description of the measure as provided in Section 10231 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

3. The Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of this special municipal election and is requested to conduct the elections in all respects as if there were only one election using only one form of ballot.

4. The Board of Supervisors is hereby requested to issue to all officers of the County charged with duties pertaining to the statewide general election, instructions to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of the consolidated election.

5. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and the Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego.
