WHEREAS, this Council has or will call a special election to be held on November 7, 1972, for the purpose of submitting to the voters of the City one initiative measure and one other measure as set forth in this resolution; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby requested to consolidate the special municipal election to be held for the purpose of submitting an initiative measure and one other measure in the City of San Diego on November 7, 1972, with the statewide general election to be held on the same date.
- 2. The exact form of the two measures to be voted upon at this special municipal election and as they are to appear on the ballot is as follows:

- 3. The Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of this special municipal election and is requested to conduct the elections in all respects as if there were only one election using only one form of ballot.
- 4. The Board of Supervisors is hereby requested to issue to all officers of the County charged with duties pertaining to the statewide general election, instructions to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of the consolidated election.
- 5. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and the Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego.
