BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the expenditure of \$4,030.00 from Transient Occupancy Tax Fund 224, and the expenditure of \$5,970.00 from Model Cities Demonstration Recreation Fund 2545, is hereby authorized solely and exclusively to provide funds for the purposes above stated.
