RESOLUTION NO. 206505

A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE OPERATION OF THE SAN DIEGO MODEL CITIES SUPPLEMENTAL TRANSPORTATION PROJECT BY THE HUMAN RESOURCES DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego has entered into a contract with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to carry out, within the City of San Diego, a Model Cities Program; and

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Demonstration Plan for the Second Action Year, the form of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 738811, authorized by Resolution No. 204770, and adopted January 27, 1972, was approved by HUD on April 6, 1972; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego and the Department of Human Resources Development, State of California, hereinafter called "Agency," entered into an agreement on July 6, 1972, to implement the Supplemental Transportation Project, hereinafter called "Project"; and

WHEREAS, the agreement with Agency has not resulted in effective implementation of the Project; and

WHEREAS, Agency and The City of San Diego mutually desire to terminate the agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Grant Agreement referred to in the first recital herein provides supplemental grant funds for the operation of said Project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The City Manager be and he is hereby authorized to request Department of Housing and Urban Development approval to change the Supplemental Transportation Project's operating agency.
- 2. Upon receipt of Department of Housing and Urban Development approval, the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized to terminate by mutual agreement the Supplemental Transportation Project agreement with Agency.
- 3. The City Manager be and he is hereby authorized to assume full responsibility for the successful implementation and completion of Project in accordance with the Grant Agreement between The City of San Diego and HUD, along with appurtenant regulations and in accordance with the terms and conditions as they may apply as set forth in Document No. 738536, on file in the office of the City Clerk.
- 4. The City Manager be and he is hereby authorized to hire manpower on a contractual basis as may be required to implement the Project.
- 5. The operation of the Project and costs incurred thereto shall be no more liberal than policies, procedures and practices applied uniformly to both federally assisted and other activities of the City.
- 6. The City shall operate Project in a manner consistent with the Project Work Program Cover Sheet, attached hereto as Exhibit A; Project Work Program, attached hereto as Exhibit B; and the itemized Program 206505

Budget, attached hereto as Exhibit C; provided, however, that if Project is not reasonably maintaining its work schedule and budget expenditures, the City Manager shall be and he is hereby authorized to initiate appropriate revisions of the Department's budget in line with actual budget expenditures either by deletion or addition, thereby minimizing the amount of unexpended program funds remaining at the end of the action year.

7. The City Auditor be and he is hereby authorized to transfer the sum of One Hundred Five Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-Eight and No/100 Dollars (\$105,328.00) from the Model Cities Second Action Year Fund No. 2902 of The City of San Diego to Fund No. 2543 of the Human Resources Department to be used by said Department and accounted for separately, solely and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for the operation of Project.

EXHIBIT A

PROJECT WORK PROGRAM COVER SHEET Supplemental Transportation Project

General Purposes: To continue to operate and maintain eleven (11) twelve-passenger vans. To develop and demonstrate an innovative approach to providing transportation with a view to:

- A. Increase accessibility to area agencies and institutions for Model Neighborhood Residents.
- B. Demonstrate to the San Diego Transit Corporation a more effective way of providing transportation to Model Neighborhood Residents as well as the city-at-large.

Scope of Services: The City's Human Resources Development Department will be responsible for the administration of the Supplemental Transportation System and will:

- A. Provide easier access to employment, health and social services for Model Neighborhood Residents, by operating eleven (11) Model Cities designated vans.
- B. Make arrangements for contracting with the City for obtaining fuel and maintenance of vans.
- C. Insure that an on-going training program consisting of both on-the-job training and "classroom-like" instructions is implemented to help employees achieve maximum performance and job mobility.
- D. Encourage agencies and residents, through advertising, to use the van service in order to increase ridership.

In order to achieve success in the above categories, agency's Model Cities staff will:

- A. Negotiate with San Diego Transit Corporation on the possibility of integrating our service with theirs.
- B. Provide assistance information and resources to the project and the operating agency for a more effective program.
- C. Assist the agency in identifying and obtaining funds from other sources.

Time of Performance: All services to be completed by January 31, 1973.

Resident Employment and Training: All positions will be filled by MNR's and training scheduled for new employees for the first two months of their employment.

EXHIBIT A

Citizen Participation: Agency covenants and agrees to allow full citizen participation in an advisory role to the project. The form of citizens participation shall be determined by mutual agreement between Director, Agency and Citizens Advisory Board. The composition of the Citizens Participation Group shall consist of no less than seventy percent (70%) Model Neighborhood Area Residents.
