WHEREAS, City studies undertaken pursuant to Council direction have led to a preliminary plan concept for the Tijuana River Valley as a basis for further feasibility analysis; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said preliminary planning concept for the Tijuana River Valley and agrees that it provides a basis for further evaluation; NOW, THEREFORE,

1. That the preliminary plan concept is accepted by the City Council at this time as a basis for proceeding with further feasibility investigations.

- 2. That the City Council authorize the City Manager, with the assistance of the Planning Department, to proceed with appropriate consultant contract or contracts to evaluate the agriculture potentials of the Tijuana River Valley. Such study should include financial feasibility of a soils management program including soil rehabilitation and recharging of the underground water basin.
- 3. That the City Council directs the Planning Department to submit the preliminary plan concept to local, public, and private agencies and organizations for study and comment as soon as feasible.
- 4. That the City Council directs the Planning Department to analyze the results of the various studies and efforts recommended above and prepare appropriate amendments for public hearings to the adopted Border Area Plan.
- 5. That the City Council urges the Planning Commission to complete its study and hearings as soon as feasible on revisions to flood plain regulations.
