WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 69.0309 of the

RST

Municipal Code, the City Manager has proposed a schedule of fees to be charged for processing Environmental Impact Reports; and

WHEREAS, the City Council should approve said schedule by resolution; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego that the following schedule of fees submitted by the City Manager be, and the same is hereby approved:

## FEE SCHEDULE

Fees or deposits as set forth herein are established to cover the cost and expense of processing environmental assessments or environmental impact analyses and preparing the preliminary environmental impact report, including public notice. Such fees or deposits as stipulated herein shall be paid at the time of submission of the environmental assessment or environmental impact analysis to the Environmental Quality Department.

For applications for environmental impact reports submitted for projects involving administrative permits (grading permits, building permits, etc.) for which there are fee schedules established within the appropriate Code sections, the following fee schedule shall apply:

- a. Submission of an environmental assessment and processing of subject assessment to a short form (Negative Declaration) final environmental impact report. . .\$50

Where, in the opinion of the Director of the Environmental Quality Department, the project is of sufficient magnitude to warrant the placement of a deposit in lieu of the aforementioned fees, a deposit of \$300 shall be placed with the application for processing of the environmental impact analysis to which will be charged the time and materials involved in the review process, noticing and such appeals that may be filed. Prior to the filing with the Planning Commission of the preliminary environmental impact report, the applicant shall place an additional deposit to cover those costs in excess of an initial deposit as may be necessary to cover those costs incurred by City.

On all applications for processing of environmental impact reports for projects which are covered by deposit systems established elsewhere in the Municipal Code (planning actions consisting of subdivisions, zonings, PRD's and large grading, public improvement and encroachment permits), an amount of \$300 shall be deposited in addition to the amount required elsewhere in the Code and said additional \$300 shall be for all charges incurred by

the Environmental Quality Department over and above those normal charges made by the applicable processing department.
