That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of said City, an agreement with HERMAN KIMMEL AND ASSOCIATES for the engineering design of a traffic signal and safety lighting system at Genesee Avenue and Mount Etna, under the terms and conditions set forth in the form of agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 742076.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the expenditure of \$2,300 is hereby authorized from Gas Tax Fund 220 solely and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for the engineering design services described above.
