## RESOLUTION NO. 207091

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, MAKING FINDINGS AND OVERRULING PROTESTS; CONFIRMING DIAGRAM AND REVISED ASSESSMENT; MAKING DETERMINATIONS ON ENVIRONMENTAL EFFECT; ORDERING ACQUISITIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS AND A TRANSFER OF FUNDS IN THE CITY TREASURY; AND MAKING DETERMINATIONS CONCERNING THE APPLICATION OF THE SPECIAL ASSESSMENT INVESTIGATION, LIMITATION AND MAJORITY PROTEST ACT OF 1931

Park District No. 3 (Mission Hills Canyon)

WHEREAS, in proceedings under the San Diego Park District Procedural Ordinance of 1969 and, in particular, Division 8 (commencing with Section 61.0801) of Article 1, Chapter VI of the San Diego Municipal Code, the Council adopted resolution of intention, Resolution No. 206497, ordering the Superintendent of Streets to prepare the Report required by said Act and pursuant thereto the Superintendent of Streets prepared said Report, consisting of plans and specifications describing the proposed acquisitions and improvements, an estimate of the costs and expenses thereof, a diagram showing the assessment district and a proposed assessment of such costs and expenses, said Report being on file with the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Council by Resolution No. 206498 approved said Report, as filed, and appointed a time and place of hearing thereon and also for a public hearing on the question of whether public convenience and necessity require such acquisitions and improvements and whether the Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931 and

the debt limitation and majority protest provisions thereof shall apply; and

WHEREAS, notices of the passage of said Resolution

Nos. 206497 and 206498 were duly published, posted and mailed

as provided by said Act, and said hearings were duly held at

the time and place so fixed and all continuances thereof, if

any, were duly made and ordered; and

WHEREAS, after the filing of a Supplemental Report by the Superintendent of Streets, the Council adopted Resolution No. 206918 proposing to make certain changes and, after notice and hearing thereon, has adopted Resolution No. 207090 ordering certain changes in the proposed acquisitions, declaring that certain city-owned lands be made available for the same purposes as the acquisitions and providing compensation to the city therefor, and revising the proposed assessment; and

WHEREAS, at said hearings all persons desiring to be heard were fully heard and all oral and written protests and objections, if any, were fully heard and this Council gave all persons present an opportunity to hear and be heard in respect to said Report and Supplemental Report, the diagram and assessment, the proposed acquisitions and improvements, the proposed changes, the boundaries of the proposed assessment district, the serial bonds to be issued to represent unpaid assessments, the question of whether public convenience and necessity require such acquisitions and improvements, whether the Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931 and the debt limitation and

majority protest provisions thereof shall apply, or in any way relating to the Report and the proceedings proposed by said resolution of intention; and

WHEREAS, the Council has received evidence relating to the Report, the Supplemental Report, the proposed acquisitions and improvements, the boundaries of the proposed assessment district, the assessment, the proposed changes and the benefits to the property to be included in the proposed assessment district; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. Written protest or objection against the proposed acquisitions and improvements had not been made by the owners of more than one-half of the area of the land included within the assessment district or of the area of property to be assessed. Except to the extent of any changes ordered by the Council, each and all oral and written protests and objections, if any, made or filed in the matter are hereby overruled and denied.

Section 2. If any court of competent jurisdiction shall hereafter determine that written protest or objection against the proposed acquisitions and improvements has been made by the owners of more than one-half of the area of land included within the assessment district or of the area of property to be assessed, then notwithstanding any such determination, the Council declares its intention to and, pursuant to Section 10311, Streets and Highways Code, does hereby overrule said protest and objection.

Section 3. The assessment, as modified by Resolution No. **207090** is hereby confirmed.

Section 4. An environmental impact report on the proposed project has been prepared and submitted to the Planning Commission and, based thereon, the Council determines that the significant effect of the project will be the conservation and enhancement of the environment by the acquisition, improvement, and maintenance of open space lands for park and recreation purposes. The Council hereby determined that the proposed acquisition is a land area:

- (1) which is primarily in its natural state and has value for park and recreation purposes, and
  - (2) which, in the opinion of the Council,
- (a) conforms to the criteria established for open space land set forth in the "Progress Guide and General Plan for The City of San Diego," as amended, and
- (b) would, if retained in its natural state or improved, enhance the present or potential value of abutting or surrounding properties or would maintain or enhance the conservation of natural or scenic resources.

Section 5. The Council approves the Report as modified by the Supplemental Report, and the modified assessment. The Council orders the acquisitions and improvements to be made, said acquisitions being as described in Resolution No. 207030

ordering changes and said improvements being as described in the resolution of intention, Resolution No. 206497. For a full and complete description of the acquisitions, the cityowned lands, the improvements, and for further particulars, reference is hereby made to the resolution of intention, the Report, the Supplemental Report, and said Resolution No.

ordered to be acquired, the Treasurer shall transfer to the

CAPITAL CUTLAY 245

Fund in the city treasury the sum of \$7,000

from any available and unencumbered moneys in the acquisition
and improvement fund established for said district, as compensation to the city for making the city-owned lands, as described in Resolution No. 207090 ordering changes, available as open space lands for park and recreation purposes.

Section 7. The Council finds and determines that public convenience and necessity requires the acquisitions and improvements and such acquisitions and improvements are ordered without the application of the Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931 and the debt limitation and majority protest provisions thereof.
